Below you will see a four-bar antecedent phrase by Steven G. Laitz. Please do the following:

- 1. Play through it several times. Play the left hand in block chords if need be.
- 2. On the back of this page, describe the texture.
- 3. Indicate the key and do a roman numeral analysis. Note that the harmonic rhythm generally is at the half- or quarter-note level, not faster.
- 4. Write a consequent phrase such that Laitz's phrase plus your consequent phrase form a parallel period. Essentially, yours will be quite similar (identical, even) until the cadence, where you need to create closure with a PAC. To do this, somehow rewrite Laitz's fourth bar such that the music arrives on tonic. Play through the entire period after you've finished.
